Dear Parent(s), carer(s) and students

The final half term of the academic year is now in full swing. GCSE and A level exams are coming to an end with many sitting their final exams today, and only a couple next week. The students have been exemplary in their focus and commitment to giving, and doing, their best in the pursuit of grades that reflect their five or two years of study and provide them with the platform for the next step in their lives. Once these are completed then it is the turn of Year 10 to sit their first round of PPEs (mocks) the week after next, while Year 12 have also been completing mock exams this past week too.

This term also sees a number of enrichment activities, trips and visits on the calendar, not least the Year 8 Oakerwood residential which is departing as I type, the Year 9 Soli trip that only got back on Wednesday after a fabulous retreat in Alton and Year 10 Duke of Edinburgh expeditions that are now in full swing. And that's before we get to the first week in July when Year 7 will embark on day trips to Kinver Camp for outward-bound and adventurous activities, Year 10 will be on work experience, Year 9 have a work related learning day linked to medical careers and a workshop with Loudmouth Theatre, Year 8 have a work related learning workshop and Year 12 are engaged in Geography field trips, a visit to London and much more.

However, there is still plenty of focussed learning in class. The perception that sometimes exists about the summer term not being as academically focused is not the case. The curriculum is designed to build term on term, year on year and right now students will be embedding learning that is paramount for next year, especially in Years 9 and 10.


