

From studying geography students will apply key skills and gain a developed knowledge and understanding of the following five key themes.

Global issues
Key geographical issues that affect people in different locations.

Landscapes and processes
Key landscapes and the processes that form them.

Environmental issues
Issues that affect environments around us and how we can affect them.

Places
Human, physical and environmental features of places, with links back to issues studied earlier in the year or course and particular focus on settlements and landscapes.

Fieldwork and enquiry (*)
Conducting on or off-site fieldwork and developing enquiry skills.

This progression will create learners with a deep knowledge of geography terminology and examples at a range of scales, with a clear understanding of processes that take place in the world around us, and with the ability to interpret a range of graphical and map based data sources to help analyse results and draw conclusions.
